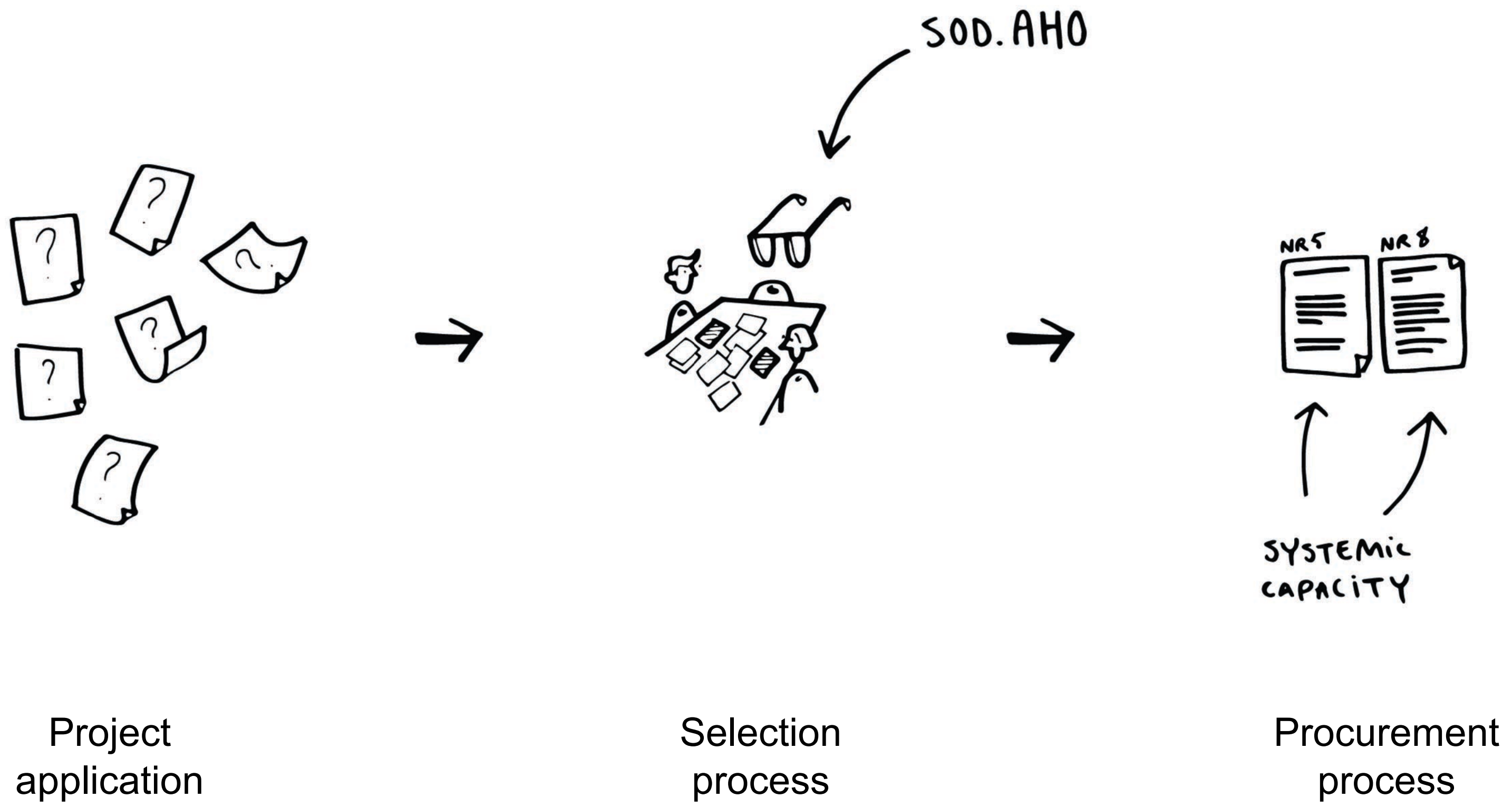
Stimulab 1.0 (2016-17)

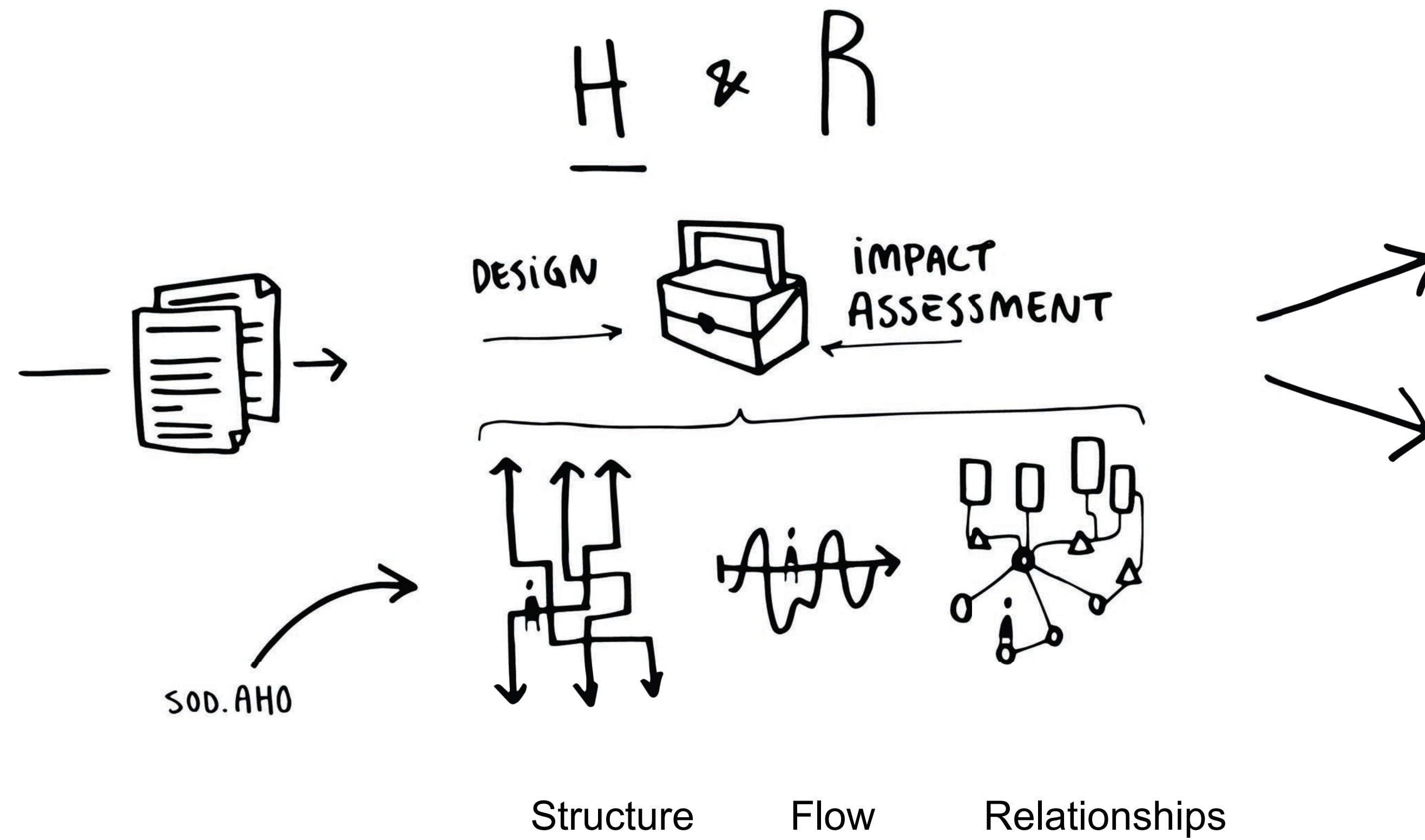

BEFORE

- Fragmented public- private system
- Must answer to EU critique
- Costly attempts to improve with limited effect

DURING

- Establishing a shared understanding and place to intervene
- Service improvement

AFTER:

- Whole picture system strategy
- Introduced learning and governance capabilities
- Introduce new public private baseline service journey - national

Manage citizen's right to drive



BEFORE

- GDPR compliance
- Behind on digitalization
- Know problem – analysed repeatedly for the last 10-15 years, but unable to improve
- Multiple part owners, fragmented service

DURING

- Finding the flex and the right place to start

AFTER:

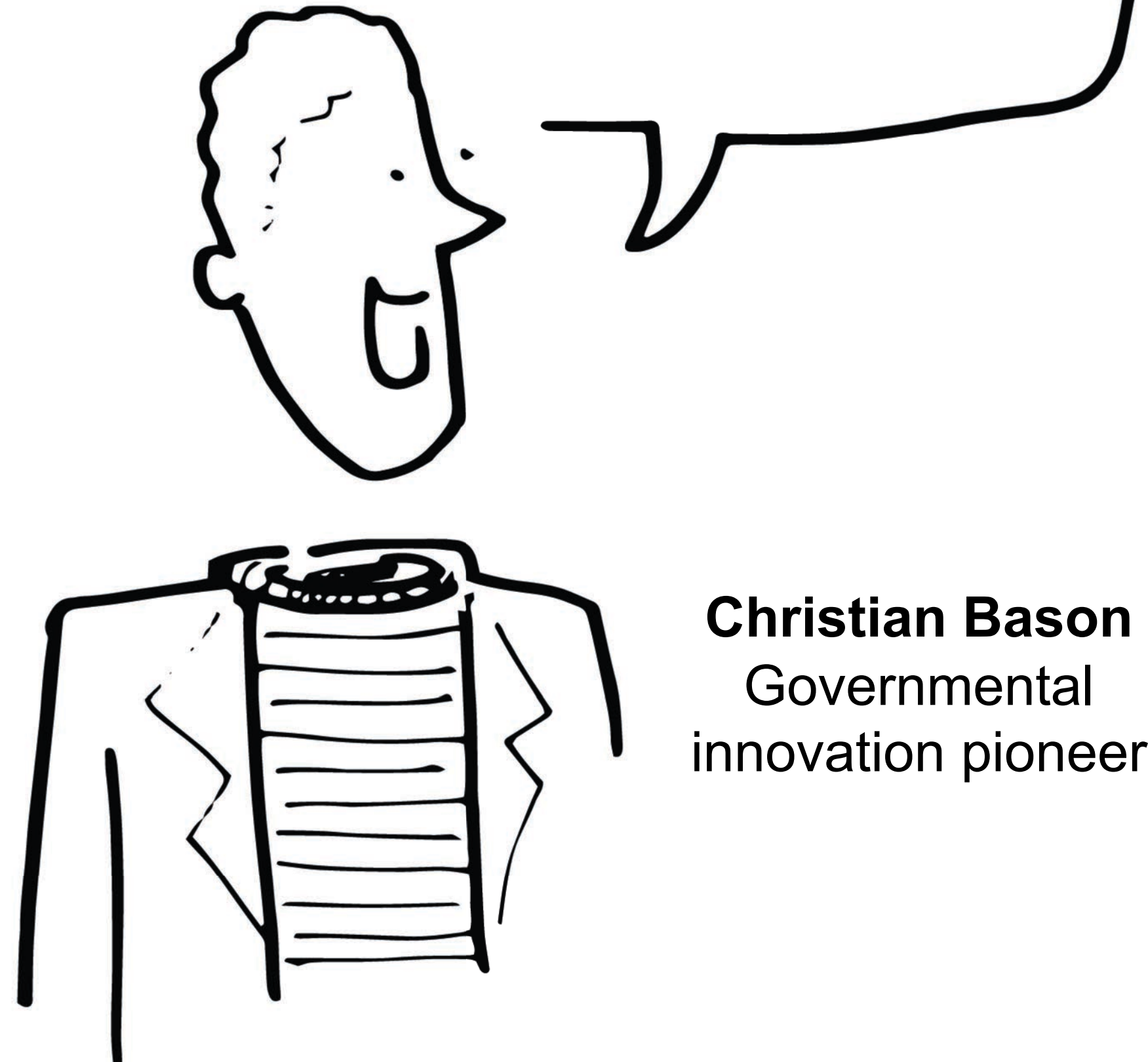
- Program concept with digital roadmap

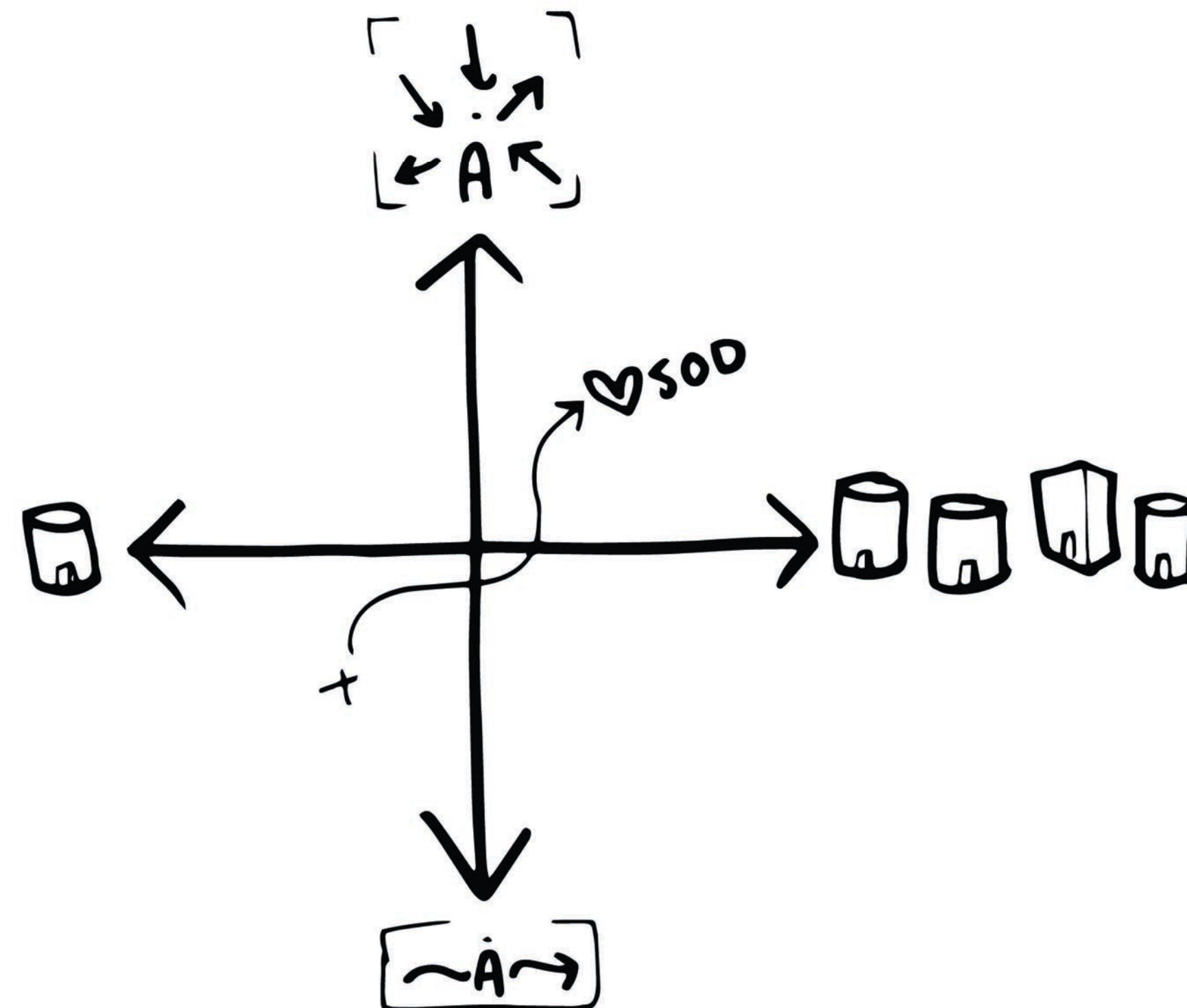
